Title: Moirai – Episode 3: She's not me **Genre:** Supernatural Thriller / Dark Fantasy

Target Audience: Adult (18+), fans of dark, character-driven dramas with supernatural

Series Logline: In a city where life and death are controlled by three immortal sisters known as the Moirai, the boundaries between human emotion and supernatural duty blur, as Victoria, Audrey, and Joey navigate their eternal responsibilities while confronting the chaos of mortal lives.

Episode Logline: In "Threads of Betrayal," Victoria introduces Kate to her secret life as a Moirai, but their intimate moment is violently interrupted by Ellie, whose obsession with Victoria spirals into deadly confrontation. The sisters and their allies must confront mortal danger, the strain of divine responsibility, and the destructive power of love gone wrong. Trust is tested, loyalties are strained, and the cost of immortality becomes dangerously tangible.

Tone & Style: Dark, cinematic, high tension with intimate human drama. Suspenseful, claustrophobic settings contrast with serene, natural spaces for fleeting moments of calm. Themes include trust, obsession, loyalty, love, morality, and the heavy burden of power.

Key Characters:

- **Victoria Kensington (Atropos):** The haunted executor, balancing human love with divine duty, tested by betrayal and mortal threats.
- Audrey Kensington (Lachesis): The moral anchor, poised and protective, stepping into action to preserve family and order.
- **Joey Kensington (Clotho):** Compassionate but fierce, her youthful energy and power are essential in saving her sister.
- **Kate:** Mortal love interest, experiencing fear, awe, and the shock of Victoria's true nature.
- **Ellie:** Obsessed, unstable antagonist whose love for Victoria turns violent, testing both sisters and mortals alike.
- **Frank:** Supportive mortal ally, highlighting the emotional stakes.

Episode Highlights:

 Opening: Victoria and Kate share a secluded picnic in the forest, revealing their deepening romantic bond.

- Victoria struggles to defend Kate while restrained by her mortal vulnerability; Ellie's obsession is revealed.

- Climactic confrontation: Joey and Audrey intervene, defeating Ellie through divine precision.
