TV COMMERCIAL:

We open on Holly Jolly Farm. Decorated for the holiday season.

NARRATOR (V.O.) Welcome to Holly Jolly Farm.

We get shots of children feeding reindeers. Families decorating cookies. And visitors taking a selfie with the farms main feature. THE WISHING TREE. A tree with an ancient myth of granting wishes.

> NARRATOR (V.O.) The ultimate family experience for the holiday season.

HOLLY COLLINS (30s) steps into frame.

HOLLY Hi, I'm Holly. Co-owner of Holly Jolly Farm. Come and join us this holiday season. We have a whole host of activities to get you in the festive spirit.

Holly takes us on tour around Holly Jolly Farm.

HOLLY (CONT'D) But watch out for that cheeky Elf on the shelf, Jolly.

Holly walks past a stand, oblivious. As her brother JONNY (30s) known as JOLLY THE Elf, sits on a shelf. He suddenly turns to a family and pulls a silly face, much to their amusement.

HOLLY (CONT'D) But most importantly.

Holly steps out from behind a large Christmas tree, known as the wishing tree.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Don't forget that special wish for Christmas. That you can make right here. You never know. It might just come true. The TV Commercial ends with an overhead shot of Holly Jolly Farm.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - OFFICE - DAY

We cut to Holly and Jolly standing opposite a TV. Holly reaches for the remote and hits the pause button.

HOLLY So, What do you think?

JOLLY I like it. How much traction is it getting?

HOLLY

Not a lot.

JOLLY Surely bookings have increased?

HOLLY The opposite. They've dropped.

JOLLY

Dropped?

HOLLY Covid hit us hard.

JOLLY Christmas is just a few days away. Surely we'll get a surge of last minute bookings?

HOLLY I don't want us to become that last resort booking.

JOLLY

If it brings in the customers then I don't mind. We just need to get through Christmas and..

Holly interrupts.

HOLLY And then what happens after that?

JOLLY What do you mean? HOLLY

After the Holiday season. We might make it to Easter. And then..

JOLLY The end of Holly Jolly Farm.

HOLLY Yep, And I would have failed Dads legacy.

JOLLY Hey, Dad left us in charge of this place for a reason. We've just hit

place for a reason. We've just hit a little bump in the road. Things will get better. I promise.

HOLLY What makes you so sure?

JOLLY Because I've been talking to a potential investor.

HOLLY

You have?

JOLLY

Yep, his name is David Jamoski. He wants to come and check the place out.

HOLLY

When?

JOLLY

Today.

HOLLY (shocked) Today!?

JOLLY

I didn't wanna tell you was because you would have made a big fuss. I want him to see Holly Jolly Farm in it's entirety.

HOLLY

Well let's hope he's interested in investing.

JOLLY He sounded very interested on the telephone.

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - DAY

A car pulls up to Holly Jolly Farm. DAVID JAMOSKI (50s) Snobby male, steps out the vehicle. He is startled by Jolly who pops up dressed as an ELF.

> (excited) David! DAVID I'm looking for Jonny Collins. JOLLY That's me! But you can call me Jolly the Elf. DAVID

JOLLY

Jolly the Elf?

JOLLY At your service.

DAVID You're an Elf?

JOLLY

That's right. Do you want me to show you Santa's workshop. I can show you where we build all the toys.

DAVID Am I in the right place? I'm looking for Holly Jolly Farm. Not the funny farm!

JOLLY The only thing funny is that toupee of yours.

David looks on in shock. He checks his hair line.

DAVID It's not a toupee. It's my real hair. JOLLY I'm sorry. You should never insult a bald man. Else there will be hell toupee.

David looks at Jolly confused.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Hell tou-pee. Get it? Hell tou-pee.

DAVID I got it. And just for the record. I do not wear a toupee.

David stares at him with a stern look on his face.

JOLLY It was a joke. I was only playing. Right this way.

Jolly leads David around the farm.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

Inside the farm house building. Holly picks up a stack of mail. She begins to flick through each letter. Big bold font on each letter. PAST DUE, FINAL NOTICE. She stares at each letter with a concerned look on her face. Before hiding them inside a nearby drawer.

HOLLY Come on Jonny. We really need this.

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - DAY

Jolly and David stop next to the Wishing tree.

DAVID Why have we stopped here?

JOLLY This is the exquisite. The cream of the crop. Our most significant feature.

DAVID It's a Christmas tree.

JOLLY Not just any Christmas tree. It's the wishing tree.

DAVID

(confused) The wishing tree?

JOLLY Yep. Been the staple of Holly Jolly farm since the fifties.

DAVID

And what's so special about this tree?

JOLLY

Well, I'll tell you what is so special about this tree. It's magical. Legend has it that this tree grants wishes.

DAVID

How is a tree supposed to grant a wish? Tree's can't talk.

JOLLY No, but they can listen. You tell the tree your wish and then wait for it to come true.

DAVID Tell me Jolly. Have you made any wishes?

JOLLY You're only aloud two wishes.

DAVID

Just two. I see.

JOLLY I've already made one. So I'm saving my final wish.

DAVID

Oh, really? And what did you wish for?

JOLLY Umm.. You don't want to know! Anyway, moving on.

They continue to walk around Holly Jolly Farm as David takes in all the sights.

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

David and Jolly exit Holly Jolly Farm house.

JOLLY So, what do you think?

DAVID

I have to say Jonny. Sorry, Jolly. I'm actually impressed. This place covers lots of acres. Ticks a lot of boxes.

JOLLY A great investment, right?

DAVID I'll need to speak to my client first. Then I'll give you a call later today.

JOLLY Thank you Mr Jomoski.

DAVID No Jolly. Thank you.

Jolly heads inside. As David walks away with a big smile on his face. He pulls out his mobile phone and Face-times his business associate. SARAH CASSIDY (30s) A shrewd business woman.

> SARAH (V.O.) David, how did it go?

DAVID Sarah, this place is a gold mine.

SARAH (V.O.) How many acres?

DAVID We're talking six or seven.

SARAH (V.O.) That's perfect.

DAVID You could build at least two factories on this land.

SARAH (V.O.) You think they will sell? DAVID

They're cash strapped, if you come in with an offer they can't refuse, how could they possibly say no?

SARAH (V.O.) In that case let me put together my offer.

DAVID

We will need to act quick. My secret trading insider told me that the information will start going out to investors from tomorrow.

SARAH (V.O.) Well you call them back at Holly Jolly Farm and tell them i'll be there tomorrow to present them an offer they can't refuse.

DAVID

And by next week. I could have the place bull dozed. Ready for to start work on the biggest clothing distribution factory in the Midwest.

SARAH (V.O.) The best clothing line the Midwest has ever seen. S C Clothing.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

Inside the building, Holly directs the children in their rehearsal for the upcoming nativity play.

HOLLY Okay Hope. It's your line.

A cute young girl. HOPE (6) steps forward to perform the narrator role.

HOPE Mary and Joseph went to stay in the stable.

Holly directs the children.

HOLLY Okay. Mary and Joseph, make yourself at home. The two young children playing Mary and Joseph follow Holly's directions.

HOPE Even though it wasn't exactly the Hilton. Mary and Joseph made the best of it.

As Holly laughs at the improvised line. Jolly enters the room.

JOLLY Hey, can I have a quick word.

HOLLY

Sure.

Holly turns to the children in the rehearsal.

HOLLY (CONT'D) We're going to take a quick five minute break. We'll pick up where we left off.

Jolly and Holly move away out of ear shot of the children.

JOLLY I just got of the phone to David Jamoski.

HOLLY

And?

JOLLY His client wants to make us an offer.

HOLLY

Really?

JOLLY Yep. A business woman. Her name is Sarah Cassidy.

HOLLY

What happens now?

JOLLY

Sarah is gonna drop by tomorrow with her proposal and when we agree to her investment. Everything will be fine. HOLLY Oh, Jonny. You have no idea how much this means to me.

JOLLY See I told you. Nothing to worry about. Holly Jolly Farm will be fine.

HOLLY I better get back to the nativity. We go live tomorrow.

JOLLY I'm off to cause some mischief.

HOLLY Go let of some Elf-esteem.

JOLLY

I like that one.

Holly smiles to herself as Jolly exits the building.

CUT TO:

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - DAY

The sun breaks through the morning sky casting a golden glow over Holly Jolly Farm.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

Holly stares into her coffee cup in a complete daze. Jolly enters in his Elf outfit.

JOLLY

Morning!

Holly snaps out her daze.

JOLLY (CONT'D) You okay there?

HOLLY Sorry, I was just in deep thought. We've got a long day ahead of us.

JOLLY It's a big day for the future of Holly Jolly farm that's for sure.

HOLLY

I've got cookie class, Christmas tree ornament making. Plus the scavenger hunt. Not to mention our first nativity performance and I haven't even started planning the big Christmas bash! Plus we have our big meeting with the investor.

JOLLY

Leave the big Christmas bash to me. If anyone knows how to throw the biggest party in town. It's me! I'll also take the scavenger hunt. That way you can focus on the nativity play.

HOLLY Thank you so much.

JOLLY Mr Jamoski texted me to say that Sarah will be arriving at eight.

HOLLY When she arrives, let's greet her. And show her around.

JOLLY

Then we can sit down and find out how much money she's willing to invest into Holly Jolly Farm.

Jolly picks up a coffee cup.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Here's to a busy day at Holly Jolly Farm.

Holly raises her cup to Jolly.

HOLLY

To a busy day.

Jolly exits the room.

BEGIN MONTAGE

- Families enjoy baking cookies with Holly.

- Children decorate their cookies.

- Jolly takes families around Holly Jolly Farm on a scavenger hunt.

END MONTAGE

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - NIGHT

As the audience filter into the building. Holly stands with the children.

HOLLY Is everybody ready?

The children all nod at Holly.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Just perform it like we practiced.

Holly stands in front of the audience. Who sit, ready for the nativity.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Ladies and Gentlemen, boys and girls. In true Holly Jolly Farm tradition. I present to you. This years nativity.

The audience applaud as Hope takes her place centre stage.

HOPE Welcome to the show. I'm glad you're here, so we can perform our special story. As Christmas draws nearer.

The audience look on smiling.

HOPE (CONT'D) A long long time ago. An angel said hello to a lady called Mary. She told her about her son, who would turn out legendary!

The audience laugh.

HOPE (CONT'D) Mary and Joseph set off to Bethlehem.

The song "LITTLE DONKEY" plays. As Hope begins singing, behind her. Mary and Joseph walk alongside a child dressed in a Donkey costume. INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - OFFICE - NIGHT

Jolly sits at his computer desk. He glances over at the clock. Which shows it's 7:00PM.

JOLLY (to self) One hour to go.

Jolly looks on inquisitive.

JOLLY (CONT'D) A quick back ground check won't do any harm.

Jolly types into the internet search engine.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Sarah Cassidy.

He begins scrolling through the findings.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Sarah Cassidy. Entrepreneur. Owner of S.C Clothing.

Jolly browses the clothing website.

JONNY Ugh! Posh people clothing.

He continues scrolling.

JOLLY What do we have here?

Jolly opens a news article.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Sarah Cassidy looking to acquire acres of land to build a state of the art factory that will manufacture clothing at double speed. Miss Cassidy said, this factory will be the first of it's kind.

Jolly leans back into his seat with a concerned look on his face.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - NIGHT

Hope delivers her final monologue. Three wise men stand opposite a cradle with a baby doll inside. Mary and Joseph crouch down next to the cradle.

> HOPE Each of them gave Jesus a precious gift and that is why we give out gifts at Christmas. Not everyone is fortunate to receive gold. It's the precious things that are worth far more than money.

The audience members stand up and applaud the nativity cast, as they all stand in line and take a bow.

HOLLY Ladies and Gentlemen. Boys and Girls. Please put your hands together for the amazing nativity cast!

Holly turns to the cast.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Well done everyone. You were all fabulous!

The cast of the nativity are met by their proud parents. As Holly looks on smiling to herself.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Before you go, I just wanted to remind everyone that tickets are on sale for the big Christmas bash. The biggest party in town.

The audience members begin exiting, Hope approaches Holly alongside her Mother FAITH (40s) holding a gift.

FAITH Hope insisted on getting you a little something.

Faith hands the gift to Holly.

FAITH (CONT'D) It's to say thank you for all the joy you bring to the community during the holiday season. HOLLY Ah, Hope you shouldn't have. Thank you.

HOPE I also made you a card.

Holly puts the present on a nearby counter. She takes the card. On the front, a drawing of Santa.

HOLLY Did you draw this?

HOPE Yep, when we were making Christmas cards. I had to be careful, so you didn't see it.

HOLLY That is so sweet of you.

Holly admires the card.

HOLLY (CONT'D) So, are you both coming to the big Christmas bash?

FAITH Of course! But there is something I wanted to ask you.

Faith looks around the room.

FAITH (CONT'D) In private.

HOLLY

Sure.

They move out of ear shot of Hope.

FAITH People are beginning to talk.

HOLLY What do you mean?

FAITH You know how people like to gossip in this town.

HOLLY I sure do. FAITH Well there are these rumors floating around.

HOLLY

What rumors?

FAITH Holly jolly farm needs investment, without it. It could be forced to shut down.

HOLLY Look, I appreciate your concerns Faith. But I can assure you that the last thing I want is for Holly Jolly Farm to shut down.

Hope walks over to Faith and Holly.

HOPE It's okay. Holly Jolly Farm won't shut down.

Faith and Holly look on shocked that their conversation was overheard by Hope.

FAITH Oh yeah? And why's that?

HOPE Because I've made a wish at the wishing tree.

HOLLY Well, let's hope that wish comes true.

FAITH We better get going. Say bye to Holly.

HOPE Bye Holly.

HOLLY

Good night!

As Faith and Hope exit. Jolly enters.

JOLLY Holly. There is something I need to tell you. A car is heard pulling into Holly Jolly Farm.

JOLLY (CONT'D) It's about Sarah.

HOLLY

What is it?

Jolly spots the car outside.

JOLLY She's here!

Holly looks on shocked.

HOLLY She's early!

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - NIGHT

Holly exits the building, whilst holding onto the Christmas card as Jolly follows. They begin making their way over to the parked vehicle next to the wishing tree.

> JOLLY Holly. There's something I need to tell you.

HOLLY Not now Jonny.

JOLLY I think it's really important you know this.

HOLLY Yeah, the town have already started the rumors about us going out of business.

JOLLY

But.

HOLLY You let me do all the talking. We desperately need this investment.

Sarah steps out the vehicle dressed in a fur coat. She looks around unimpressed.

HOLLY (CONT'D)

Sarah?

That's me.

HOLLY We're Holly and Jonny. Owners of Holly Jolly farm. Would you like to follow us inside.

SARAH That won't be necessary.

Holly looks on confused.

SARAH (CONT'D) I'm going to make this brief.

JOLLY Watch out for the..

Sarah steps backwards and puts her foot in some animal poop. She looks down disgusted.

SARAH My shoes! They're ruined.

HOLLY I'm so sorry.

SARAH These are Dior!

JOLLY Now they're manure.

Sarah begins wiping her shoe across the ground.

SARAH

Gross!

Sarah composes herself.

HOLLY You said you wanted to make this brief.

SARAH I want to make you an offer.

HOLLY

Go ahead.

SARAH Two million Dollars. HOLLY Did you say two million dollars?

SARAH That's right.

HOLLY You want to invest two million dollars into Holly Jolly farm?

SARAH

No sweetie! I want to buy Holly Jolly farm for two million dollars.

HOLLY Wait a second? Did you say buy?

SARAH You heard me.

HOLLY But Holly Jolly farm is not for sale.

SARAH Everything has a price.

Sarah pulls out a cheque for two million dollars.

SARAH (CONT'D) Here is a cheque for two million dollars. All you have to do is accept it. I can have all the paper work drawn up in twenty four hours.

HOLLY I can't sell this place. It's been in my family for generations.

JOLLY

Explain to my sister why you really want to buy Holly Jolly farm.

HOLLY

What are you talking about? I thought you found an investor who wanted to invest in the business?

JOLLY

So did I. Until I did a quick background check on our potential investor. You see, Sarah here, is a successful business owner. S C clothing right? That's correct.

JOLLY

Sarah is looking for somewhere to build a new factory. A first of it's kind. And she's found the perfect place. Right here at Holly Jolly farm.

HOLLY

Well it's not for sale! Christmas is so important to the people of this town. No amount of Money can buy tradition.

SARAH

But I am offering you two million dollars. You could open another Christmas farm elsewhere!

HOLLY

This isn't just a Christmas farm.

JOLLY You heard my sister. It's not for sale.

SARAH

I don't get it. You're turning down a huge amount of money. For what? A business model around Christmas.

JOLLY

Do you even know the true meaning of Christmas.

SARAH Of course. To capitalize on sales and hit maximum profit.

HOLLY

That is not what Christmas is all about.

Sarah spots Holly holding onto the Christmas card from Hope.

SARAH Oh don't tell me. It's all about Santa. A man who works one day a year!

Sarah scoffs.

SARAH (CONT'D) One day a year! I wish I had his job.

Suddenly the star on top of the wishing tree begins to brighten. Illuminating the farm.

SARAH (CONT'D) What is happening?

The star dims as the light flickers out.

HOLLY I've never seen that happen before.

The door to Holly Jolly farm house begins to open. A bright light shines from inside.

JOLLY I think we're being summoned inside.

SARAH Summoned for what?

JOLLY I don't know?

They begin making their way inside Holly Jolly farm house.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - NIGHT

They emerge through the bright light. Holly and Jolly enter dressed as Elves.

SARAH What is happening?

The inside of Holly Jolly farm now transformed into the north pole.

SARAH (CONT'D) Can someone explain to me what is happening right now?

JOLLY Did the property Brothers stop by?

Jolly discovers a scroll letter. He pulls it opens and begins reading it to himself.

JOLLY (CONT'D) I can explain. SARAH

Please do.

JOLLY It looks like your wish has been granted.

SARAH

What wish?

JOLLY The wish you made next to the wishing tree. It looks like it's been granted.

SARAH I don't recall making a wish.

HOLLY Actually you did. You wished that you had Santa's job.

SARAH I said that in a figure of speech.

JOLLY Well it looks like you're in a whole world of trouble.

SARAH

Gimme that!

Sarah snatches the scroll from Jolly.

SARAH (CONT'D) Dear Sarah. Your wish has been granted. With the help of my trustee Elves. Holly and Jolly. I have left everything you will need to do my job.

Sarah looks on in shock.

SARAH (CONT'D) You will need to prepare for operation Christmas. I have transformed Holly Jolly farm into a mini north pole.

JOLLY Looks great.

SARAH

You will need to prepare for the delivery of seven billion presents worldwide. There are clauses for this. And P.S, I'd like to point out that I don't work just one day a year. A lot of preparation goes into operation Christmas. So good luck. Signed Santa Clause.

JOLLY The good news is, Santa has left a Manuel.

Jolly holds up a book called Operation Christmas.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Operation Christmas.

Jolly begins flicking through the pages.

JOLLY (CONT'D)

If we follow all of Santa's instructions. What could possibly go wrong?

SARAH No, No! This can't be real. This has to be a prank, where's the tv crew? You can come out now! You got me. Okay, you got me.

JOLLY

This isn't a prank. You heard Santa. There are clauses you need to follow.

SARAH What clauses?

Jolly takes back the scroll.

JOLLY

Right here.

Jolly points to some tiny writing on the scroll. Sarah looks at it closely

SARAH If you do not deliver all the presents on time. Then you will not be able to switch back until the clause is complete. JOLLY Another way to look at it is you could be stuck as Santa for some time.

SARAH What? So i'm supposed to be Santa and deliver presents?

JOLLY On time. Don't forget that part.

SARAH And then I can switch back?

HOLLY That's what the clause says.

SARAH

I've got it. I'll send all the kids a gift voucher. Now can I switch back?

HOLLY

Not quite.

JOLLY Yeah, that's not how it works.

SARAH Why not? Every child will get one.

HOLLY Well you see, not every child deserves a present.

JOLLY Holly's right. That's why on page one. It says, you need to check the list.

SARAH Check the list?

HOLLY Yeah, you know.

SARAH No, I don't know. Enlighten me.

JOLLY He's making a list.

HOLLY Checking it twice. Sarah looks on confused. JOLLY HOLLY (CONT'D) Gonna find out who's been Gonna find out who's been naughty or nice. naughty or nice. Holly and Jolly break out in song. BOTH Santa Clause is coming to town. Sarah interrupts the singing. SARAH Okay, Okay. I get it. Enough singing. HOLLY Well, it looks like we have a lot of work to do. So let's start by checking the list. SARAH Oh, I'm so glad you are embracing all of this. JOLLY Of course we are. We're Elf's. Sarah looks at Jolly unimpressed. JOLLY (CONT'D) Plus we never thought we'd get to work with the real Santa. SARAH I'm not Santa. My name is Sarah. JOLLY We've got two days to make a believer out of you. SARAH The sooner we get this done. The better. JOLLY It says head to the library of

letters in order to check the list.

SARAH And where is the library of letters? JOLLY I'm not quite sure? Santa gave our place a makeover after you made your wish. HOLLY Only one way to find out. Follow me. They begin walking through the modified house. In front of them, a long corridor with doors. All named. JOLLY This door says Sleigh exit. SARAH Can I enter that room and exit this place? HOLLY You can exit that room on Christmas eve, when you set off on your sleigh. JOLLY To your first delivery. HOLLY And that will be in the republic of Kiribati. SARAH I'm sorry? Where? JOLLY The republic of Kiribati. It's a country in the central pacific ocean with a population of one hundred and twenty thousand people. It's.. Sarah interrupts Jolly. SARAH A hundred and twenty thousand people?

> HOLLY Yep, which is why we need to check that list.

They pass a door that reads "Santa Surveillance."

SARAH Santa Surveillance? What's in that room?

HOLLY Oh, this room helps Santa keep track of everyone that's been naughty and nice.

Jolly flips through the pages of the operation Christmas Manuel.

JOLLY Also says here that we will be able to watch your every move on Christmas eve.

SARAH Great! Whilst I'm out grafting. You get to sit back with your feet up and watch.

JOLLY It doesn't say anything here about having our feet up?

Holly leads them to a door. A sign on the door reads LIBRARY OF LETTERS.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Ah, here it is.

They enter the room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - LIBRARY OF LETTERS - DAY

Jolly begins reading from the operation Christmas Manuel.

JOLLY It says here all letters written to Santa have been stored in this room alphabetically and each child's name has been added to the list.

They look around the room in awe. A room full of bookshelves and filing cabinets. Each sorted in alphabetical order.

> HOLLY Take a seat Santa.

Sarah takes a seat on a throne at a long table.

HOLLY I present to you, the list.

Holly hands Sarah a scroll.

SARAH This is Santa's list? Doesn't look very big. I was expecting it to be a lot bigger than this.

Sarah pulls open the scroll to reveal the longest list in the world, as it continues to unravel, getting longer and longer until it covers the whole room.

SARAH (CONT'D) What is this?

JOLLY Santa's list.

HOLLY I would probably start at A.

Sarah looks at Holly unimpressed by the comment.

SARAH Have you seen how long this list is. It will take me days to read this.

JOLLY Not if you believe.

SARAH Believe me. Millions upon millions of names. I will probably still be checking this list by next Christmas.

HOLLY The real magic of Christmas comes from believing.

Sarah reluctantly picks up the list. She begins reading the names out slow.

SARAH Aabheer, Aadhan, Aadhira, Aabhas, Aabhavannan, Aadhya.

Suddenly Sarah begins reading the names out a little faster.

SARAH (CONT'D) Aaban, Aabharan, Aabid, Aadarsh.

Her speed of reading out the names increases.

SARAH (CONT'D) Aagam, Aarav, Aaron, Aayan, Adrian.

She stops and stares at Holly and Jolly confused.

SARAH (CONT'D) What is happening?

HOLLY Believe yet?

SARAH Believe what?

HOLLY That you are Santa.

JOLLY Only Santa can read the list that fast.

Sarah continues to read the list. Almost sounding like the worlds fastest rapper.

SARAH Bentley, Corey, Harley, Jayden, Katie, Lilly, Wendy, Zara.

Sarah sits in shock.

SARAH (CONT'D) What just happened?

JOLLY You just read every single name on Santa's list.

SARAH

I did?

HOLLY Wait a go Santa. JOLLY And from the top.

SARAH

What?

JOLLY Making a list.

HOLLY Checking it twice.

JOLLY Gonna find out..

Sarah interrupts.

SARAH Okay, Okay. Please spare my ears. I'll check the list again.

JOLLY From the top lets go.

Sarah begins reading out the names super fast. Sounding like she is talking complete gibberish.

SARAH Aabheer, Aadhan, Aadhira, Aabhas, Aabhavannan, Aadhya. Aagam, Aarav, Aaron, Aayan, Adrian. Bentley, Corey, Harley, Jayden, Katie, Lilly, Wendy, Zara.

JOLLY Wow Santa! That was impressive.

HOLLY Seeing is believing.

JOLLY Yep, only Santa can read his list that fast.

SARAH Did that really just happen?

HOLLY

It sure did.

Jolly flicks through the pages of Operation Christmas.

JOLLY Says here, now that we've checked the list. It's time to fuel up on the main food group. Sugars and more sugars.

SARAH Whoah! I tend to watch what I eat. I'll take a salad.

HOLLY Santa, you're going to need all the energy you can get. So we have to make sure your nutrition for the big night is right.

They all exit the library of letters. And begin walking down the long corridor looking at each door. Sarah spots the sleigh exit door.

> SARAH I think I'm going to take the exit.

Sarah rushes towards the door.

SARAH (CONT'D) Right I'm outta here. Exit this way.

Sarah rushes through the door.

JOLLY She never reads the small print.

Zoom on door that reads "EXIT THIS WAY - VIA SLEIGH"

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SLEIGH EXIT - DAY

Sarah looks around the room for the exit door.

SARAH

Where's the exit door? It said exit this way.

JOLLY Yes, exit this way. Via the sleigh.

Holly pulls off a sheet covering the sleigh.

HOLLY

Whilst we are here, maybe it's a good time to check over the sleigh.

JOLLY

Yep, Elf and safety is very important here at Holly Jolly Farm.

SARAH Was that supposed to be an Elfism?

JOLLY

Maybe?

HOLLY So what do you think of your sleigh Santa?

SARAH It's just a sleigh. You see these things in shopping malls.

HOLLY

You'll be navigating this around the whole world on Christmas eve.

SARAH

I normally get chauffeur driven. Can I not just call my driver Bob? So he drive me around?

JOLLY

Afraid not Santa.

SARAH

Speaking of calling. Where on earth did I put my mobile phone? Oh, it's in my handbag in my car. The one day I didn't have Bob drive me. My life is turned upside down.

HOLLY

Don't worry. The sleigh is kitted out with the latest GPS technology. You'll be able to navigate this around the world no problem.

SARAH

I can hardly wait.

JOLLY Oh, sounds like someone is a little hangry.

SARAH I'm not hangry. JOLLY

Santa! I can tell that your energy and enthusiasm is dropping.

SARAH My enthusiasm for operation Christmas is currently at zero.

JOLLY Let's get you to the dining room.

They exit the room.

HOLLY The dining room is just here.

They enter through the door.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DINING ROOM - DAY

Inside the room a long table and throne.

JOLLY Take a seat Santa.

Sarah takes a seat on the throne.

HOLLY

Santa, we have stick to your traditional Christmas diet. I'll go and fetch it.

Holly exits the room.

SARAH Well, during the holiday season I usually avoid chocolate and I tend to stick to Caesar salads.

Jolly opens a page in the Operation Christmas Manuel.

JOLLY All your meal plans are right here and have been prepared by your nutritionist.

SARAH Wait, Santa has a nutritionist?

JOLLY Sure does, their job is to keep Santa's sugar and energy levels up. SARAH Next you'll be telling me Santa has a personal trainer.

JOLLY Nope! Delivering all those presents on Christmas eve is the equivalent of working out three hundred and sixty five days a year, twice a day.

SARAH In that case. When I get outta here. I'll make sure I cancel my gym membership.

Holly re-enters pushing a food cart full of dishes covered in cloche's. She places the first dish on the table and removes the cloche.

HOLLY First dish. Chocolate Gateau.

SARAH I'm sorry this isn't going to work for me.

HOLLY

Next dish.

Holly removes the cloche.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Candy canes.

JOLLY

My favorite.

HOLLY And not forgetting.

Holly removes the final cloche.

HOLLY (CONT'D)

Cookies.

SARAH

Great.

HOLLY And a gallon of milk to wash it all down with.

Holly places the gallon of milk next to Sarah.

JOLLY

Bon appetite.

Sarah looks at the food disgusted.

SARAH

I'll have one cookie and that's it.

Sarah picks up a cookie. She begins eating it. Her facial expressions change from nonchalant to delight.

SARAH (CONT'D) These are pretty good.

Sarah demolishes the cookie. She turns to the candy canes.

SARAH (CONT'D) Hmmm. Tasty.

Next up Sarah picks up a handful of cake.

SARAH (CONT'D) Be rude not too.

She piles the cake into her mouth and continues indulging, going from dish to dish.

SARAH (CONT'D) Cake. I love cake.

Holly and Jolly look on bemused as Sarah scoops up two slices of cake and begins eating them both at the same time. Her mouth covered in chocolate.

> JOLLY Wow Santa! Somebody was hungry.

Sarah grabs the milk and begins gulping it down.

HOLLY

Thirsty too.

Sarah belches.

SARAH

Excuse me.

HOLLY Have you finished your feast Santa?

SARAH I am so stuffed. I need a lie down.

Jolly flicks through the Operation Christmas Manuel.

SARAH

Good!

HOLLY You need to get plenty of rest. Ready for Christmas eve.

Sarah tries to get up from the throne.

SARAH Maybe a little help here.

Jolly helps Sarah up from the throne. Her mouth still covered in Chocolate.

JOLLY

Erm.

Jolly points to his mouth.

JOLLY (CONT'D) You got a little..

SARAH

Oh!

Sarah wipes away the chocolate with her hand.

JOLLY We have another busy day scheduled tomorrow Santa. We are getting closer and closer to operation Christmas. So get plenty of rest.

They begin exiting the room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - NIGHT

Jolly and Holly show Sarah to her room.

HOLLY Right in here Santa.

They enter the cosy bedroom. A Christmas tree in the corner. A roaring fire. Sarah crashes onto the bed, within seconds she begins snoring.

> JOLLY Santa's had a busy day.

HOLLY Yep. And tomorrow it's even busier. JOLLY Do you think Santa can pull this off? HOLLY I'm not sure? I just don't know if She will be ready. They exit the room as Sarah lays on the bed snoring. INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - BEDROOM - DAY Sarah lets out a satisfying stretch in bed. She awakens to the realization she's still at Holly Jolly Farm. SARAH Oh, I was hoping it was all a dream. JOLLY (O.S.) Santa! Sarah sits up in the bed. JOLLY (O.S.) (CONT'D) Wakey Wakey! Sarah pulls the duvet over her head and hides. INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY Holly and Jolly await for Sarah to join them. She enters the room. HOLLY I take it you slept well? SARAH Actually, I had a great sleep. Although when I woke up, I was hoping this was all one big nightmare. JOLLY Nope. It's very real. And we have one final day to get you prepared ready for operation Christmas.

Jolly stares at Sarah with a big smile on his face.

SARAH Why are you smiling like that?

JOLLY Because it's Christmas eve eve!

HOLLY Tomorrow's the big day.

JOLLY But first up. Breakfast.

HOLLY

This way.

They all make their way to the dining room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DINING ROOM - DAY

Sarah takes a seat on the throne.

SARAH

So, what's for breakfast?

On the table a dish with a cloche over it awaits Sarah.

HOLLY For breakfast. Milk and cookies.

Sarah picks up a cookie.

JOLLY Dig in Santa. We got a busy day.

Sarah begins eating the dish of cookies. Then gulps down some milk.

JOLLY (CONT'D) First up on the agenda. Suit fitting.

SARAH

What?

JOLLY We gotta make sure the suit fits you.

SARAH Why would you do a suit fitting after I've just demolished a dish of cookies.

JOLLY Sorry Santa, I didn't write the manual. I'm just following it. HOLLY Well. If you'd like to follow me to wardrobe. We have a suit to fit you in. They exit the dining room. Jolly turns to Sarah. JOLLY Can I ask you a question. SARAH Sure. JOLLY Why do you not like Christmas? SARAH It's not that I don't like it. It's just. JOLLY Just what? SARAH Two years ago. I had the worst Christmas eve of my life. JOLLY What happened? SARAH I was all set to get married. But my fiancé didn't show. JOLLY I'm sorry to hear that. SARAH Do you know how humiliating it is, to be left standing at the alter? Ever since that day. I've just surrounded myself with work, to keep me busy and remind me of the times I want to forget. JOLLY Must be tough for you, especially

as Christmas eve draws near.

SARAH I try not to think about it.

JOLLY Well if it helps. You are loved by millions of people Santa.

SARAH That helps a little.

JOLLY I'm serious, you're an inspiration to people all over the world. You're also my hero too.

SARAH Ah, thanks Jolly.

HOLLY I don't mean to interrupt. But we're here.

They stop outside a door with a sign on it that says WARDROBE. Holly opens the door.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - WARDROBE - DAY

In front of them, Santa's suit on a mannequin. The focal point of the room.

JOLLY There it is. The famous suit of any superhero.

Sarah looks at the suit with no enthusiasm.

SARAH

Oh no.

She feels the material.

JOLLY It's the suit. I thought you'd appreciate such fine clothing.

SARAH I'm a fashion designer. This doesn't work for me.

JOLLY But you have to wear the suit. It's tradition. SARAH Yeah, if you want me to wear this. I'm gonna have to make a few adjustments.

JOLLY (shocked) A few adjustments?

Holly and Jolly look at each other concerned.

BEGIN MONTAGE:

- Holly and Jolly nervously watch on in the background.

- Sarah measures out some material.

- Jolly covers his eyes
- Sarah cuts some red material.

- Sarah holds up the red trousers followed by a pair of scissors as Jolly once again covers his eyes.

- Sarah uses the sewing machine to stitch together several fabrics.

- Jolly watches on unsure what to make of the changes to Santa's suit.

END MONTAGE

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - WARDROBE - DAY

Holly and Jolly await for the revealing of Santa's new suit.

Almost ready.

minose ready.

Sarah steps out to reveal the new and improved Santa suit. Which consists of a long Santa coat. Red shorts over white tights and knee hight boots.

> HOLLY Wow! Santa. Great job on the suit.

JOLLY You look amazing.

SARAH You think so? JOLLY

Absolutely.

Jolly smiles at Sarah with a twinkle in his eye.

HOLLY I think you'd do a fabulous Christmas range.

SARAH Hmmm.. Something I might consider next year. If I manage to complete operation Christmas that is.

JOLLY You'll complete it. We will be by your side the whole way.

SARAH Now I'm suited up. What's next on the agenda?

Jolly flicks through the operation Christmas manual.

JOLLY The fun part.

Jolly shows the page to Holly.

HOLLY Down and deliver.

SARAH What is down and deliver?

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - TRAINING ROOM - DAY

A living room with a Christmas tree and Chimney is replicated inside a training room.

JOLLY Down and deliver is the basic method of delivering presents.

Jolly walks over to the fireplace.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Down the chimney.

Jolly walks over to the Christmas tree.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Present delivered under the tree.

Jolly walks back to the fireplace.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Back up the chimney.

SARAH Down, deliver, back up. Got it.

HOLLY Okay then Santa. Let's have a little run through.

SARAH Right now?

HOLLY Right now. If you exit the door. There are some stairs that lead to the chimney.

Sarah exits the room. As Holly and Jolly nervously look at each other.

JOLLY This is Santa's big test.

HOLLY If she passes. Then Santa is ready for operation Christmas.

JOLLY Okay Santa. Down the chimney.

Jolly and Holly await for Sarah to arrive down the chimney.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Okay Santa. Down the chimney.

HOLLY

Santa?

Suddenly some legs appear dangling inside the chimney.

SARAH (O.S.) Guys, a little help here.

Holly and Jolly look at each other with a disappointed look on their face.

JOLLY How can this be? I thought she'd be ready.

HOLLY

Me too.

JOLLY We can't send Santa out tomorrow. At this rate, no presents will get delivered.

SARAH (O.S.) Guys! I'm still stuck here. A little help.

They both help pull Sarah through the chimney. As Sarah emerges with a crushed present.

SARAH (CONT'D) Down the chimney. Deliver the present.

Sarah looks down at the damaged present. She makes her way over to the tree and throws the present under the tree.

SARAH (CONT'D) Present delivered.

Sarah makes her way over to the chimney.

SARAH (CONT'D) How do I get back up the chimney?

Holly and Jolly look at each other concerned.

HOLLY Let's run the drill again.

Sarah exits the room. But waits near the door and listens in on Holly and Jolly's conversation.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - TRAINING ROOM DOOR - DAY

JOLLY (O.S.) If Santa doesn't believe. Then how is she supposed to deliver all those presents?

HOLLY (O.S.) I don't know Jolly, I'm not sure if Santa can pull this off? INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - TRAINING ROOM

Jolly and Holly nervously await Santa to arrive down the chimney.

JOLLY Okay Santa. Down the chimney.

Holly and Jolly look at each other in anticipation.

HOLLY Go for it Santa.

JOLLY Did Santa get lost on the way to the chimney?

HOLLY I don't know? Let me go and check.

Holly exits the room.

JOLLY Santa? You can climb down the chimney... In your own time.

Holly re-enters the room.

HOLLY Santa's not there.

JOLLY

Oh no.

They both rush out of the training room in a panicked state.

JOLLY (CONT'D)

Santa!

HOLLY Santa, where are you?

They stop outside the open dining room door and spot Sarah slumped in the chair at the table.

JOLLY

Santa?

SARAH Admit it. I'm a terrible Santa. JOLLY You're not a terrible Santa.

SARAH I'm going to ruin everybody's Christmas.

JOLLY You're not going to ruin anybody's Christmas.

SARAH I should never have made that stupid comment.

JOLLY Hey listen to me. We're not going to let you fail.

HOLLY There is a secret to all of this.

SARAH Oh yeah. What's that?

HOLLY You just need to believe.

JOLLY Holly's right.

HOLLY You need to believe in yourself.

JOLLY You have to believe you are Santa.

HOLLY The moment you believe that. Everything will fall into place.

Sarah glances at them with a dejected look.

SARAH You really think so?

JOLLY

I know so!

HOLLY Today has been a long day. Why don't you go and get some rest. JOLLY There is just one more task for you tomorrow.

SARAH Oh yeah, and what task is that?

JOLLY

We gotta load the sleigh. Then you will be taking off and flying to your first location.

HOLLY So go and get some rest. You've got a busy day.

JOLLY

And night!

HOLLY Ahead of you tomorrow.

As Sarah is about to exit the room. She stops and turns to Holly and Jolly.

SARAH Thank you. For everything.

JOLLY

Anytime Santa.

Sarah exits the room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SLEIGH EXIT - DAY

Holly and Jolly greet Sarah upon her arrival.

JOLLY Morning! I trust you slept well.

SARAH Why are you more happier than normal?

JOLLY (excited) Because it's Christmas eve!

SARAH Don't remind me!

HOLLY

Yep. We got a busy day ahead. First up, load the sleigh, then pre flight meal. After that. Get you suited up. Then operation Christmas can officially begin.

JOLLY

There is a lot at stake today Santa. You're either going to end up staying here longer than you anticipated. Or you're going to pick yourself up and start believing that you can do this.

SARAH

I'll try.

HOLLY

Every sack has a number. We have to load the sacks into the sleigh in numerical order.

SARAH How many sacks are there?

HOLLY One hundred and ninety five.

SARAH

A hundred and nighty five?

HOLLY

There are one hundred and ninety five countries in the world.

SARAH That's a lot of deliveries.

JOLLY

Sure is.

HOLLY Which is why we number all the sacks.

JOLLY

The good news is. The sleigh has been programmed to take you to each destination. It will stop at each house. In present order.

HOLLY Sack one will be your first destination. And sack one hundred and ninety five. SARAH My last. I got it. HOLLY Well in that case. Let's get loading these sacks onto the sleigh. They begin loading the sacks onto the sleigh in numerical order. SARAH So what am I actually delivering? Holly and Jolly stop in their tracks. They turn to Sarah. JOLLY Presents. SARAH Yeah, I know that. But where's the presents? JOLLY In the sacks. Sarah picks up a sack. SARAH They're empty. JOLLY Ready for the magic? HOLLY Look closely. Sarah opens up the sack and looks inside. SARAH It's empty. Holly and Jolly look at each other worried. SARAH (CONT'D) What? Is there supposed to be something inside.

JOLLY The magic will happen.

Jolly looks at Holly.

SARAH

JOLLY You won't mess this up. You just gotta believe and once you start believing. I think you'll do a great job Santa.

SARAH

Really?

JOLLY

Yeah.

Sarah smiles at Jolly as they continue to loads sacks onto the sleigh.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DINING ROOM - DAY

Sarah sits head of the table, as Jolly and Holly sit nearby. Dishes of food all laid out as the trio enjoy their last feast together.

JOLLY In a few hours time. Millions of children will be in bed sleeping. (MORE)

JOLLY (CONT'D)

And when they wake up in the morning, they will open the presents you have delivered for them.

SARAH

I just hope I can deliver all the presents on time.

JOLLY

You'll be passing through different time zones. Instead of having twenty four hours to deliver all those presents. You'll have thirty two.

HOLLY

That's a lot of hours spent delivering. You better eat up. You're going to need all the energy you can get.

SARAH

All I know is after this is all said and done. I need a vacation. Somewhere I can let my hair down.

HOLLY

You could always come to the big Christmas bash.

SARAH

What's the big Christmas bash?

JOLLY

It's the biggest party in town. We throw it every year, the whole town get together. We sing, we dance and..

SARAH

And..

JOLLY It's probably going to be our last ever bash.

SARAH What makes you think that?

JOLLY Before you made your wish. SARAH

I still maintain it was a figure of speech.

JOLLY You wanted to purchase Holly Jolly farm.

SARAH

I did. But that was before I experienced the magic of Holly Jolly Farm. I've grown very fond of this place.

JOLLY It's a shame your business associate had me believe you wanted to invest in the place.

SARAH If it's any conciliation. I did see David's name on the naughty list.

HOLLY Well if this is our last supper at Holly Jolly Farm. Let's enjoy it.

Holly raises a glass of milk.

HOLLY (CONT'D) A toast to you Santa.

Sarah raises a glass of milk.

SARAH A toast to the two people who have helped me rediscover my love of Christmas.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - WARDROBE -NIGHT

Sarah exits the wardrobe room dressed in her modified Santa suit. She joins Holly and Jolly as the trio walk towards the sleigh exit door.

SARAH Down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

HOLLY You've got this. JOLLY

It's the pre flight jitters. Once you're out there. You'll be fine.

SARAH

I hope so.

HOLLY We're going to be watching from the Santa surveillance room.

JOLLY

Here.

Jolly hands Sarah a wireless ear piece.

SARAH What's that?

JOLLY

A Santa speaker. Stick it in your ear. That way, we can communicate with you anywhere around the world.

Sarah places the wireless ear piece in her ear.

HOLLY Okay Santa. Pre flight checks.

They enter the sleigh exit room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SLEIGH EXIT - NIGHT

Jolly grabs a clipboard, he begins checking over the sleigh.

JOLLY

Reindeers?

Holly enters with several reindeers.

HOLLY

Prancer, Dasher, Cupid and Dancer. Reporting for duty.

Holly attaches the reindeers reins to the front of the sleigh.

HOLLY (CONT'D) More reindeers incoming.

JOLLY

Presents.

Jolly checks the sleigh.

JOLLY (CONT'D)

Check.

Holly enters with more reindeers.

HOLLY Blitzen, Donner, Comet, vixen and Rudolph reporting for duty.

JOLLY

Reindeers check.

Holly begins attaching the rest of the reindeers to the sleigh.

JOLLY (CONT'D)

Santa?

Sarah steps forward.

SARAH

Check.

Sarah steps into the sleigh.

JOLLY Let's get this baby fired up.

Jolly flicks on the dashboard display switch.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) System online.

Sarah checks the seating area.

SARAH Is there a seat belt?

Jolly attaches the seat belt around Sarah's lap. They lock eyes and smile at each other.

HOLLY Okay Santa. We're off to the surveillance room. We will be with you every step of the way.

Holly and Jolly exit the room.

SARAH Wait a second. Remind me again, how does this thing work? Sarah plays with the steering control.

SARAH (CONT'D) Did you say whichever way I steer the sleigh. The reindeers will take me in that direction?

Jolly responds via the earpiece.

JOLLY (V.O.) That's correct Santa.

A voice emerges from the sleigh's dashboard.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Launching in ten.

SARAH Wait a second.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.)

Nine.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SANTA'S SURVEILLANCE - NIGHT

Inside the Santa Surveillance room. Holly and Jolly watch on the LCD Screens.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (0.S) One. Operation Christmas activated.

JOLLY

Off she goes.

The sound of Sarah screaming is heard as the sleigh exits Holly Jolly farm.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) One minute to your first destination.

SARAH (V.O.) You didn't tell me I would be traveling this fast.

JOLLY Just hold on Santa.

Holly and Jolly watch on the surveillance screen.

SARAH (V.O.)

Ow!

HOLLY Santa. Are you okay? SARAH (V.O.) I just hit a little turbulence. JOLLY That's normal. SARAH (V.O.) Oh no! SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) System offline. SARAH (V.O.) I accidentally hit the switch. The dashboard has gone off. JOLLY Don't panic. It's going to take 30 seconds to boot back up. HOLLY Santa. You're 20 seconds away from your first destination. JOLLY The sleigh wont boot up in time. You're going to have to manually steer the sleigh in the right direction. SARAH (V.O.) Which direction. Suddenly radio interference is heard through the earpiece. JOLLY Santa? Are you there? Jolly worryingly looks at the LCD Screens. SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) System reboot. SARAH (V.O.) Holly, Jolly. Come in. JOLLY Santa! It looks like you've taken the wrong turn.

SARAH (V.O.) I'm sorry I panicked. When nothing goes right. Take a left. So I did.

HOLLY It's okay. The system should reprogram your route.

JOLLY You'll need sack two.

SARAH (V.O.) Sack two. Got it.

Holly and Jolly look at each other nervously.

HOLLY Remember down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

SARAH (V.O.) I am never going to fit down that chimney.

JOLLY Santa. Now is the time to start believing.

SARAH (V.O.) I'm climbing in the chimney.

Jolly turns to Holly.

JOLLY This is it.

SARAH (V.O.) I'm a little stuck.

JOLLY Close your eyes.

SARAH (V.O.)

Okay?

JOLLY Say it with me. I believe I can fit down this chimney.

SARAH (V.O.) I believe I can fit down this chimney. JOLLY Say it like you believe it.

SARAH (V.O.) I can fit down this chimney.

JOLLY

Again.

SARAH (V.O.) I can fit down this chimney.

Holly and Jolly await Sarah's response.

JOLLY Open your eyes.

SARAH (V.O.) Whoa! What just happened? I'm in the living room. I fitted down the chimney.

JOLLY Santa. A little quiet. We don't want to wake up the children.

Sarah lowers her tone.

SARAH (V.O.) Of course.

JOLLY For the first time. You believed Santa.

HOLLY The true magic of Christmas is believing.

JOLLY Now open the sack.

SARAH (V.O.) Opening sack.

JOLLY Look inside.

SARAH (V.O.) What? How is that even possible?

JOLLY It's the magic Santa! HOLLY Now the present that is glowing inside the sack. That's the gift that belongs to that house. You just need to put it under the tree.

SARAH (V.O.)

Got it.

The sound of the present being thrown under the tree is heard in the Santa Surveillance room.

> JOLLY Careful with those presents.

> > SARAH (V.O.)

Sorry!

HOLLY Okay Santa. Up the chimney and onto the next house.

SARAH (V.O.)

Got it.

JOLLY Wait a go Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) So each house I go to, the presents will appear inside the sack?

JOLLY

That's right.

HOLLY The present that is glowing belongs to that house.

SARAH (V.O.) I always thought that all the presents got loaded onto Santa's sleigh.

HOLLY If Santa's sleigh was loaded with twenty two million presents. It wouldn't take off.

SARAH (V.O.) Good point. I'm at the next house.

Holly and Jolly watch on the Santa surveillance screen.

JOLLY Okay, same again. Down the chimney, deliver the present. Up the chimney. SARAH (V.O.) Down the chimney. They hear Sarah head down the chimney. SARAH (V.O.) Deliver the present. HOLLY And now up the Chimney. SARAH (V.O.) Ah, they left me a note. And a glass of milk. JOLLY What does the note say? SARAH (V.O.) Dear Santa. I left you some milk and whilst writing this note, I got hungry and ate the cookie. Jolly and Holly hold back their laughter. SARAH (V.O.) Jeez! Thanks kid. They hear Sarah gulp down the milk. SARAH (V.O.) Up the chimney. JOLLY Santa, you're gonna have lots of cookies and milk left out for you. HOLLY Think of it like this, every time you eat a cookie. You're recharging your energy. SARAH (V.O.) Got it. I think I'm starting to get the hang of this.

> JOLLY Keep up the good work Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) Next house. Down the chimney.

Jolly and Holly watch on with their feet up, whilst eating cookies and drinking milk.

SARAH (V.O.) Umm.. Guys! This present seems a little big for this sack.

JOLLY Try and be a little careful.

They hear a crashing noise from inside the house.

SARAH (V.O.) Sorry! My fault.

They continue to hear items falling and crashing to the ground.

HOLLY Santa? Are you okay?

SARAH (V.O.) A surfboard? Really! Who asked for a surfboard.

JOLLY

Santa, if you could pick the Christmas tree back up of the ground. And everything else you've knocked over with it.

Suddenly Holly spots an adult making their way towards the living room.

HOLLY Abort! Abort! Santa, get outta there!

We hear Sarah run to the fire place.

SARAH (V.O.) Up the chimney.

Holly and Jolly watch on as the home owner makes their way into the living room.

HOME OWNER (V.O.) That stupid cat!

SARAH (V.O.) Close call. JOLLY It's okay Santa. The cat got the blame.

HOLLY Santa. I just wanted to let you know. Some kids have asked for bikes.

SARAH (V.O.) Oh, Great!

JOLLY Maybe stand away from the tree when you pull it out the sack.

SARAH (V.O.) Next house.

Jolly turns to Holly.

JOLLY Santa is really picking up the pace.

SARAH (V.O.) Present under the tree.

As Sarah is about to exit the home. She stops near a table.

SARAH (V.O.) Ohh, candy canes.

As Sarah eats the candy canes. Behind her, a dog begins to growl.

SARAH (V.O.) Hey there little pooch.

The dog continues to growl.

SARAH (V.O.)

Nice doggy.

Holly and Jolly spot Sarah running away from the dog on the surveillance screen.

SARAH (V.O.) Up the chimney! Up the chimney.

JOLLY Are you okay Santa? SARAH (V.O.) That dog is now on the naughty list!

HOLLY That is Australia complete.

JOLLY Okay Santa, you're now entering a new time zone.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching England.

SARAH (V.O.) Ohh! When I deliver to Buckingham palace. Can I say hello to the King?

JOLLY We haven't got time for that Santa.

Sarah speaks in a British accent.

SARAH (V.O.) Do I have time for a cup of tea?

JOLLY

No.

SARAH (V.O.) Bah humbug.

JOLLY Your next house has two gifts to deliver.

SARAH (V.O.) Down the chimney.

As Sarah is about to place the presents under the tree. Twin boys COREY (6) and JAYDEN (6) approach her.

HOLLY Oh no! Code red, not in bed! I repeat, code red, not in bed.

Sarah turns around.

Oh, hi.

SARAH (V.O.)

JAYDEN (V.O.) Who are you?

SARAH (V.O.) I'm Santa. JAYDEN (V.O.) Where's your beard? Jolly intervenes. JOLLY Say you um.. You shaved this morning! Holly looks at Jolly bewildered. JOLLY (CONT'D) What? It's the first thing that came to mind. SARAH (V.O.) Good question. I um.. Had a shave this morning. COREY (V.O.) But you're a girl. SARAH (V.O.) That is also another good point. COREY (V.O.) I thought Santa was a man. JAYDEN (V.O.) With a beard and a big belly. COREY (V.O.) Like my Daddy. SARAH (V.O.) If I let you in on a little secret. You promise not to tell anyone? COREY (V.O.) Promise. SARAH (V.O.) I made a wish that I had Santa's job. And guess what? JAYDEN (V.O.) What?

SARAH (V.O.) It came true and If I don't deliver all the presents, not only will I ruin Christmas, but i'll be stuck as Santa until I complete operation Christmas.

Holly and Jolly watch on in anticipation.

SARAH (V.O.) So what I need you to do is go back to bed and when you wake up, forget this little meeting ever took place.

COREY (V.O.)

Okay.

Corey and Jayden rush off to bed. As Sarah looks on relieved.

SARAH (V.O.) Phew! Up the chimney.

JOLLY Wow Santa! You handled that great.

SARAH (V.O.) I didn't know what to say.

JOLLY Just keep delivering those presents Santa and you'll be done in no time.

SARAH (V.O.) Down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

JOLLY Great pace Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) Moving onto the next sack.

HOLLY Wow! Santa is really getting those presents delivered at a rapid rate.

JOLLY Only one hundred and ninety three sacks to go.

Holly looks at Jolly and shakes her head.

JOLLY (CONT'D) What? She missed the first sack.

HOLLY First stop coming up.

SARAH (V.O.) Down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

JOLLY

Next house.

Holly checks her smart watch.

HOLLY According to Santa's watch. Her energy levels are down by half. I don't want her to feel the burn out just yet.

JOLLY At the rate Santa is going, that could be a possibility.

HOLLY Twenty gifts in twenty seconds. Wow!

JOLLY She is super fast.

Holly checks her watch.

HOLLY Her levels are continuing to drop.

JOLLY Seems like kids aren't leaving out as many cookies as they used too.

SARAH (V.O.) Tell me about it!

JOLLY Keep an eye on Santa's energy levels. If Santa's energy drops. I may have just the thing.

Jolly looks over at the clock.

HOLLY Santa has almost finished delivering all the presents in England.

JOLLY Alright! Wait a go Santa.

BEGIN MONTAGE

Jolly and Holly watch on the Surveillance screen.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Next sack Santa.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching Spain.

SARAH (V.O.) Hola Espana!

Jolly and Holly continue to watch on the surveillance screen. Holly glances at her smart watch as her face shows concern.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching Italy.

SARAH (V.O.) Ciao Italia!

Jolly and Holly look on impressed.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching Greece.

SARAH (V.O.) Geia sou Ellada!

JOLLY Santa knows every language around the world.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching China.

SARAH (V.O.) Ni Hao Zhongguo.

Holly glances at her watch showing real concern.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Now approaching the United states of America. SARAH (V.O.) Good morning America!

END MONTAGE

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SANTA'S SURVEILLANCE - NIGHT Jolly glances over at the clock. He turns to Holly.

JOLLY Santa is doing a great job. But our delivery window is getting thinner by the second.

HOLLY This is the final sack. But we have a slight problem.

JOLLY What's the problem?

HOLLY Santa's energy is at an all time low.

JOLLY Hey Santa. You're on the final sack.

HOLLY You have forty minutes left of your delivery window.

SARAH (V.O.) Forty minutes?

JOLLY You can do this Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) Okay, here goes. Down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

JOLLY Wait a go! Next house Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) Down the chimney. Deliver the present. Up the chimney.

HOLLY Keep that pace going. SARAH (V.O.) Guys, this is really starting to take a toll on my body.

JOLLY Just hold in there Santa. The finish line is near.

HOLLY We need to do something or Santa will crash and feel the burn.

SARAH (V.O.) Next house. Down the chimney.

Suddenly a little girl voice is heard in Santa's Surveillance room.

HOPE (V.O.)

Santa?

SARAH (V.O.)

Hi.

Holly turns to Jolly.

HOLLY

It's Hope.

HOPE (V.O.) Did you get my letter?

SARAH (V.O.) Of course I did.

HOPE (V.O.) Then why are you bringing me a present?

SARAH (V.O.)

Because..

HOPE (V.O.) It's not what I asked for in my letter.

Holly turns to Jolly.

HOLLY Jolly, to the library of letters. Hurry!

Jolly rushes off in a hurry.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Santa. Jolly has gone to retrieve Hope's letter. Jolly rushes into the room holding the letter. JOLLY Here. I can't read it. I'm outta breath. HOLLY Santa, Hope wrote. Dear Santa. This year I don't want any presents, instead, I just want my Mom. Holly hesitates. HOLLY (CONT'D) To get better and not be sick anymore. Holly looks at Jolly in shock. HOLLY (CONT'D) I didn't know Faith was sick. SARAH (V.O.) Hope. HOPE (V.O.) Yes Santa. SARAH (V.O.) What you're going through right now. It's tough. But you are a brave little girl. I'm going to put this present under the tree. Because you've been a good girl and you deserve it. HOPE (V.O.) Thanks Santa. SARAH (V.O.) Merry Christmas. JOLLY Sorry Santa. But you need to get to your next house. Time isn't on our side. SARAH (V.O.) Did you know her Mom was sick?

HOLLY

No.

SARAH (V.O.) Well is there anything we can do?

JOLLY It's out of our hands Santa.

HOLLY All we can do is keep Faith in our prayers.

SARAH (V.O.) I thought Christmas was about joy and happiness. Right now, I'm not feeling very joyful.

JOLLY

It's the tough part of the job Santa. No matter how tough times can be. Kids will still find time to write to you.

HOLLY You give these kids hope!

SARAH (V.O.) I guess your right.

JOLLY

I hate to break this to you Santa. But in twenty five minutes. Kids will begin waking up, hoping to find a present under their tree.

SARAH (V.O.) I'm starting to feel the fatigue.

JOLLY It's good thing I came prepared.

SARAH (V.O.) Prepared for what?

JOLLY

Sleigh. Open emergency energy.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Opening emergency energy.

JOLLY Santa. Inside that secret compartment. You will find a super sugar cookie. And some milk. SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Super sugar cookie and Milk activated. Sarah eats the cookie and gulps down the milk. SARAH (V.O.) Hmmm. JOLLY I made it myself. SARAH (V.O.) Tasty! JOLLY It should kick in any second .. Now! SARAH (V.O.) Wow! What a rush! JOLLY Okay Santa. Go and work your magic. SARAH (V.O.) Operation Christmas is about to be completed. Sarah begins to deliver super quick. As Holly and Jolly look on amazed. HOLLY Wow! Where did you get that super sugar cookie? JOLLY A little recipe I put together. HOLLY Care to share? JOLLY Flour, eggs, butter, cornstarch, baking soda, salt and sugar. Lots of Sugar!

Jolly looks over at the clock.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Santa you have twenty minutes.

HOLLY You are down to the last few presents.

JOLLY Two more houses.

Jolly and Holly look at each other in excitement.

HOLLY Final house.

JOLLY You've done it Santa!

HOLLY Operation Christmas complete!

Holly and Jolly begin dancing around in celebration.

SARAH (V.O.)

Oh no!

They stop their celebrations.

JOLLY What is it Santa?

SARAH (V.O.) The sleigh didn't reprogram the route. I still have bag number 1 to deliver.

Jolly looks at the time.

JOLLY And you have eighteen minutes to do it.

HOLLY Oh no. This isn't good.

JOLLY We're going to fail operation Christmas.

SARAH (V.O.) Hey! I don't wanna hear that defeated attitude. JOLLY But Santa. You only have..

Jolly checks the time.

JOLLY (CONT'D) Seventeen minutes!

SARAH (V.O.) Jolly that's not the spirit I wanna hear.

SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Next destination. Republic of Kiribati.

SARAH (V.O.)

Mauri!

JOLLY I'm sorry Santa. But by the time you get there. You're never going

to deliver all those presents in thirteen minutes.

HOLLY Santa, you have arrived.

SARAH (V.O.) How long I have got?

JOLLY Exactly twelve minutes.

SARAH (V.O.) Twelve minutes is plenty.

Jolly looks on nervous.

SARAH (V.O.) Sing it with me Jolly. On the twelve day of Christmas, Santa gave to me. A present under the tree. Next house.

Jolly checks the time.

SARAH (V.O.) On the eleventh day of Christmas Santa gave to me. A puppy? Really? Oh he's cute.

JOLLY Ten minutes Santa. SARAH (V.O.) On the tenth day of Christmas. Santa gave to me, two presents under the tree.

JOLLY You've got nine minutes remaining Santa.

SARAH (V.O.) On the ninth day of Christmas. Santa gave to me. A new cuddly teddy.

Jolly turns to Holly.

JOLLY It's going down to the wire.

SARAH (V.O.) On the eight day of Christmas. Santa gave me. Another Super Sugar Cookie.

Sarah begins racing around super quick as Jolly looks on amazed.

JOLLY Santa. You've got one minute and two houses remaining.

HOLLY Santa. You're going to have to chose one house that won't receive a present this year.

JOLLY Holly's right. One house won't be able to receive a gift this year.

SARAH (V.O.) Not on my watch!

Jolly looks at the clock.

JOLLY I can't watch!

SARAH (V.O.) On the second day of Christmas. Santa gave to me. A bike? Really?

JOLLY Santa. You've got ten seconds!

SARAH (V.O.) On the first day of Christmas. HOLLY Nine. JOLLY Eight. SARAH (V.O.) Santa gave to me. JOLLY Seven. HOLLY Six. JOLLY Five. HOLLY Four. JOLLY Three. HOLLY Two. SARAH (V.O.) The final present under the tree. SLEIGH DASHBOARD VOICE (V.O.) Operation Christmas complete. Holly and Jolly celebrate in the Santa's surveillance room. JOLLY Santa! You've done it. HOLLY With one second to spare! SARAH (V.O.) Mission complete. I'm coming home. JOLLY Let's go and greet her upon her arrival. Holly and Jolly exit the room.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

They make their way through Holly Jolly farm house towards the sleigh exit door. Sarah exits the room and greets them.

SARAH What a night.

JOLLY Santa, you did it!

SARAH No. We did it! I couldn't have done this without you.

JOLLY I live by the motto, Team.

SARAH

Which is.

Jolly looks at Holly.

JOLLY Together, everyone.

HOLLY Achieves more.

SARAH I might have to steal that.

TANNOY VOICE (V.O.) Please report to Santa Surveillance.

They all look at each other puzzled by the request.

JOLLY Where did that come from?

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - SANTA'S SURVEILLANCE - DAY

They enter the room and notice SANTA checking out the surveillance footage.

SANTA Corey and Jayden. That was a close call.

SARAH

Santa?

SANTA

My suit!

SARAH

About that.

SANTA It's a good thing i've got spares.

SARAH How did it feel not to work Christmas eve this year?

SANTA

I missed every second of not being in my sleigh delivering presents to all the good boys and girls around the world. More importantly. How did it feel to do my job?

SARAH

Honestly Santa. At first I hated it. But then I realized just how magical Christmas can be in the eyes of Children and Adults.

SANTA And what did you learn?

SARAH

Never to make a wish about having your job ever again.

They all laugh.

SARAH (CONT'D)

But I get it. You don't just work one day a year. The preparation was intense.

SANTA

That's why, from tomorrow. Operation next Christmas begins.

SARAH

So what happens now?

SANTA

You have fulfilled your wish. Completed the clause. You're free to go. SARAH

What happens to Holly Jolly Farm?

SANTA I will have it transformed back to normal. And all this will seem like a vivid memory.

JOLLY Wait, so that means we won't remember this night.

SANTA You may remember small things here and there. But those memories will soon fade away.

Sarah turns to Holly and Jolly.

SARAH I guess this is goodbye?

JOLLY Wait, Sarah. Before you go. Just incase you forget about this night. I just wanted to say.

Sarah turns to Jolly in anticipation.

SARAH What is it?

Jolly hesitates.

JOLLY It's nothing really.

SANTA

Но. Но.

Santa clicks his fingers.

SANTA (CONT'D)

Ho.

The room returns back to normal. Holly Jolly Farm restored as any trace of the north pole disappears, along with Santa and Sarah.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

Holly stares into her coffee cup. Jolly enters the room.

JOLLY Merry Christmas! Holly snaps out her daze. HOLLY Merry Christmas. JOLLY Hey, you okay? HOLLY I had the weirdest dream. JOLLY About what? HOLLY It's gonna sound crazy but. This place was transformed into. JOLLY The North pole. HOLLY Did you have the same dream as me? JOLLY Yeah. HOLLY How is that even possible? JOLLY Hey check it out. A present under the tree. HOLLY Jolly, you shouldn't have. JOLLY I didn't. HOLLY There's a present for both of us. They unwrap the gift. Inside a small box. A keyring with the word "TEAM." HOLLY (CONT'D) Team.

> JOLLY Together, everyone.

HOLLY Achieves more.

JOLLY Wait a second.

Jolly looks at the key ring confused.

JOLLY (CONT'D) What happened last night?

HOLLY I'm not quite sure.

JOLLY Everything is just a blur.

HOLLY One thing I do know is that tonight, it's the big Christmas bash.

JOLLY Rumors have been flying around about this place.

HOLLY Jolly. There is something I need to tell you.

JOLLY I already know.

HOLLY

You do?

JOLLY

The final demand letters. I chose to ignore them too. Believing someone would invest in this place.

HOLLY

I guess I was scared at the thought of losing this place. But now, I've come to terms with it.

JOLLY If we are going out. At least we can go out in style. With one final big Christmas bash.

HOLLY I think it's only right that we address the situation tonight. JOLLY

I agree. The people who have supported us through tough times have the right to know.

HOLLY Well, we better start getting ready.

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - NIGHT

With Holly Jolly Farm decorated throughout. People begin arriving for the big Christmas bash. A band plays on a stage in the background. Hope arrives with Faith as the pair are greeted by Holly.

> HOPE Merry Christmas Holly.

HOLLY Merry Christmas to you too.

FAITH She couldn't wait to come and see you.

HOLLY Well it's good to see you.

Faith turns to Holly.

FAITH

Hey, I know it's Christmas. But people are still talking about this place shutting it's doors. I wish I had the money to help keep it open.

HOLLY That's so sweet of you. But don't worry. We will be addressing those rumors tonight.

FAITH

Okay.

HOLLY Now go and have some fun!

Hope and Faith head straight into the party. In the distance, a car pulls into Holly Jolly Farm. Sarah steps out of the vehicle. She begins making her way over to the wishing tree. Sarah stares at the wishing tree.

SARAH (CONT'D) I hear you only grant two wishes. So my second wish is..

Sarah hesitates.

SARAH (CONT'D) I wish for Hope's mom. Faith to get better.

The wishing tree begins lighting up. Holly turns to Jolly.

HOLLY Whats up with the wishing tree?

JOLLY Could be a power surge. We've got so much power operating the big bash.

Suddenly all the lights shut down for a matter of seconds before starting back up again.

SARAH Wish granted.

Holly and Jolly head up on to the stage as the live band finish playing. Sarah watches on from the distance, unseen.

HOLLY Alright. Let's hear it for the band everybody.

The audience give the band a round of applause.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Firstly. Merry Christmas everybody. Now, I know rumors have been circulating for weeks. And tonight we are here to address those rumors.

JOLLY You see, we love Holly Jolly Farm. But recently it's been tough. Financially. The audience look on in anticipation.

HOLLY (CONT'D) After tonight. Holly Jolly Farm will close it's door.

A wave of shock rumbles through the audience.

SARAH

Wait.

They all turn and spot Sarah. Who begins making her way towards the stage through the crowd. Jolly turns to Holly.

JOLLY

It's..

HOLLY

Santa.

Sarah enters the stage.

SARAH

May I?

She takes the Microphone.

SARAH (CONT'D) Hi everyone. My name is Sarah Cassidy.

Hope points to Sarah.

HOPE Mommy, It's Santa.

FAITH

Okay sweetie.

SARAH

The reason I'm here tonight is to announce that Holly Jolly Farm won't be closing it's doors.

Holly looks at Jolly.

SARAH (CONT'D) Instead we will be creating the ultimate Christmas experience where families can come and enjoy our brand new facilities.

HOLLY Is this really happening?

SARAH

There will be new rooms and behind each door. A magical experience.

Holly interrupts Sarah.

HOLLY Do tell everyone about these new magical experiences.

Holly and Jolly look on intrigued.

SARAH

Holly Jolly Farm will become North pole HQ. You will be able to check what Santa is doing at the North pole in our Santa surveillance room.

Holly looks on impressed.

SARAH (CONT'D) The sleigh room, where you will be able to meet Santa's reindeers whilst enjoying a photo in the sleigh.

Jolly looks on impressed.

SARAH (CONT'D) Not to mention, our cookie creation station. Jolly has the best cookie recipes.

JOLLY

I do?

SARAH

We will also be creating some Holly Jolly Farm fashion. Designing the perfect clothing for the holiday season. Which will be available to buy. With all proceeds going to charity. JOLLY Excuse me, miss.

SARAH

Yes Jolly.

JOLLY

This sounds all great. In fact it sounds better than great. What I would like to know is, when does all this come into play?

SARAH

As a special someone told me. Santa doesn't work just one day a year. He plans for Christmas all year round. So we will be getting to work in the next couple of days.

JOLLY

We?

SARAH That's right. Me you and Holly. Team.

JOLLY Together, everyone.

HOLLY

Achieves more.

SARAH

Team.

HOLLY Well, you heard it folks. So let's celebrate.

The band take their place on the stage. Holly and Jolly approach Sarah.

HOLLY (CONT'D) Sarah, we can't thank you enough.

SARAH

I can't thank you guys enough.

Holly brings over three glasses of Champaign.

HOLLY

I'd like to raise a toast to the best present anyone in our position could have wished for.

JOLLY Yeah, you really are like Santa.

Sarah almost spits her drink out.

SARAH

A toast.

They all raise their glasses. As the band resume playing. Jolly turns to Sarah.

JOLLY

Would you like to dance?

SARAH

I'd love too.

INT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM HOUSE - DAY

We rejoin Holly on a packed out Holly Jolly Farm as she is greeted by Hope and Faith.

HOLLY Hi Hope. Are you both ready for Christmas?

FAITH Almost, Hope insisted on delivering her letter personally to Santa. Here at Holly Jolly farm.

Holly looks on deep thought. As she spots the name Sarah on the envelope and in brackets the word Santa. Holly snaps out of her daze..

> HOLLY How is everything Faith?

FAITH The doctors can't believe it. They said its like some kind of miracle. I'd love to thank the person who was looking over me.

In the distance. The coupled up Sarah and Jolly walk around Holly Jolly Farm holding hands as they approach the trio.

SARAH

Hey everyone.

HOPE I wrote you a letter to Santa. Can you make sure Santa gets it.

Hope winks at Sarah as Faith looks on confused.

SARAH I will make sure Santa gets your letter.

FAITH Well, we have a busy day here at Holly Jolly Farm. The place is looking great.

HOLLY Thanks Faith. I'm glad everything is working out.

Faith and Hope head off to explore Holly Jolly Farm.

HOLLY (CONT'D) So how are the newly engaged couple?

SARAH We are fabulous. More importantly. How is my future sister in law?

HOLLY

I couldn't be better. Business is booming. We are having people traveling from the northeast, the southeast. Families from all over are coming here to check out our Christmas experience.

SARAH This is just the beginning. Tonight I think we should toast, to our first year as a team.

JOLLY Well, In the meantime i'm off to make some super sugar cookies. What are you up too?

HOLLY Now that we can afford to hire more employees. I'm just going to take in the beauty of Holly Jolly farm.

Holly begins watching on as families embrace the fun. As the sun light beams over Holly Jolly farm.

EXT. HOLLY JOLLY FARM - NIGHT

Near the wishing tree. Jolly and Sarah sit cozied up together. As Holly sits opposite them.

HOLLY

I could sit here all night. It's just so peaceful.

SARAH

The accountant was checking over the books today and Holly Jolly farm has turned over a huge profit in the last twelve months.

JOLLY Wow! That's incredible. SARAH

It sure is.

HOLLY I had this weird flashback today.

SARAH Oh yeah, and what was that?

HOLLY

It was Hope's letter to Santa. It was addressed to Sarah and in brackets Santa. Then I had this sudden flashback that we were preparing you to be Santa.

JOLLY That sounds insane.

HOLLY It only lasted a few seconds.

SARAH It may sound insane. But it happened.

JOLLY

What?

SARAH Last Christmas. I switched Christmases with Santa.

JOLLY

Wait a second. Is that even possible.

SARAH It's very possible.

HOLLY

Now it's starting to come back to me.

SARAH

It will come back in pieces. Then fade away like a distant memory.

HOLLY How do you still remember?

SARAH Because I was the person who made the wish next to. Sarah points to the wishing tree.

SARAH (CONT'D) The wishing tree.

JOLLY

So let me get this straight. You wished you had Santa's job and it came true.

SARAH That is exactly what happened one year ago today.

JOLLY That must have been the best Christmas ever! Having Santa's job. Delivering presents around the world. Wow! I wish I had Santa's job.

The light on top of the wishing tree begins to brighten.

SARAH

Oh, Jolly!

JOLLY

0ops!

FADE OUT.
