EXT. NIGHTY NIGHT - DUSK

The sun sets on a charming snow-covered village.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Once upon a time, in a land far, far away, there was the sleepy vampire village of Nighty Night. Not scary or mean vampires but rather the most friendly folks you ever could meet.

A bright winter moon rises.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

And the friendliest family of them all was little Vickie's family.

EXT. VICKIE'S HOUSE - NIGHT

A snowman stands in the front yard.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Vickie lived with her little sister Veronica and her mom and dad. And her parents were the most famous bakers in all of the land.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

VICKIE, 9 years old, sleeps in bed.

A cuckoo clock the strikes the hour and a CUCKOO BAT springs out.

CUCKOO BAT

Cuckoo! Cuckoo!

VERONICA, 6 years old, enters with a burning candle.

VERONICA

Vickie wake up. It's time for school.

Vickie wakes up yawning.

VICKIE

Where's mom and dad?

VERONICA

They're gone. But they left us a note.

Vickie looks at the note.

INT. BAKERY - NIGHT

MOM and DAD wear white aprons and chef hats in their bustling bakery.

MOM (V.O.)  
 Sorry girls, we had to leave early  
 because of the upcoming snowstorm. Go  
 straight home after school. And Vickie,  
 absolutely no ice-skating tonight.

DAD (V.O.)  
 We put fresh bread in your lunch baskets.  
 Remember, mommy and daddy love you.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

Vickie tucks ice skates into her straw basket.

EXT. VICKIE'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Vickie wears a red-hooded coat, holding her basket.

VICKIE  
 Veronica hurry up!

Veronica steps out proudly wearing her own red-hooded coat.

VICKIE (CONT'D)  
 You're wearing the same coat as me. Why  
 do you always have to be such a copycat?

Veronica is saddened by Vickie's reaction.

EXT. MAIN STREET - NIGHT

Vickie strides through the town square with Veronica trailing behind her.

VERONICA  
 Ahh fiddlesticks! I forgot to fill up the  
 bird feeder.

VICKIE  
 You're always feeding those silly birds.  
 But what have they ever done for you?

VERONICA  
 Mommy and Daddy say to always be kind to  
 our animal friends. Can we go back?  
 Please?

VICKIE  
 No. We'll be late for school.

EXT. SCHOOL - NIGHT

Veronica finds a note on the school door. Vickie reads it.

VICKIE  
Dear students, school is cancelled  
tonight due to the impending snowstorm.  
Sincerely, Principal Virgil.

A snowball explodes against the door. VICTOR, 9 years old,  
runs up.

VICTOR  
How cool is this? No school!

VERN and VALERIE, his 6 years old twin siblings, make a  
snowman.

VALERIE  
Hi Veronica.

VERN  
Come help us make a vampire snowman.

Veronica runs over to join them.

Victor holds out his skates.

VICTOR  
Want to go ice-skating?

Vickie pulls out her skates.

VICKIE  
I'll race you!

She sprints toward a frozen lake, right past a "Warning Thin  
Ice!" sign.

EXT. FROZEN LAKE - NIGHT

Vickie and Victor ice-skate on the lake.

VICKIE  
Watch this.

Vickie does a double axel, followed by an upright spin.

VICTOR  
Wow!

VICKIE  
That's nothing. Wait til you see my  
triple lutz.

Veronica wobbles up in a pair of oversized worn-out skates.

VICKIE (CONT'D)

Where'd you get those skates?

VERONICA

I saw you take your new ones so I grabbed your old ones.

VICKIE

She always copies me. How do you get Valerie and Vern not to be copycats?

VICTOR

That's easy. I tell them if they copycat me The Witch will get them.

Veronica staggers on the ice. She reaches out for help, but Vickie steps away from her.

VICKIE

If you don't go back to playing with your friends The Witch will get you.

VERONICA

Mommy and Daddy say The Witch is only mean because people are mean to her.

VICKIE

Fine, be a little tag along, but I'm not picking you up when you fall.

VERONICA

I won't fall.

VICKIE

(to Victor)

Race you to the other side.

Vickie and Victor skate off.

Veronica's laces come undone.

The WITCH flies over on her broomstick.

Veronica waves up to her smiling.

WITCH

What a nice little girl. No one has ever waved hello to me before.

The Witch waves back smiling.

Veronica trips over her laces and falls down.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Oh dear, I better go help that nice girl.

The Witch floats down next to Veronica.

Victor sees The Witch from across the lake.

VICTOR

Vickie The Witch is after your sister!

VICKIE

Oh no!

Vickie speeds back toward Veronica.

The Witch uses her broom to walk on the ice and lifts Veronica up.

WITCH

Are you okay?

VERONICA

Yes, I'm just not good at skating.

WITCH

Me either, no one ever taught me how.

VERONICA

My big sister Vickie is the best skater in Nighty Night. She can teach us both.

WITCH

Really?

The Witch suddenly gets hit by two snowballs.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Ouch!

Vickie and Victor glide up doing ice shaving hockey stops.

VICKIE

Stay away from my sister witch!

WITCH

I was just trying to help.

VICTOR

You'll turn her into a frog!

Victor fires a snowball, knocking off her hat.

VERONICA

Leave her alone! She's nice.

Vickie nails The Witch with a snowball, knocking her down.

Veronica goes to help her but Vickie grabs her.

VERONICA (CONT'D)

Let me go. She's my friend.

WITCH

I'll get you for this you big meanie!

VICKIE

Not without your broom you won't.

Vickie kicks her broom across the creaking ice.

The Witch crawls on the ice after it, shivering.

WITCH

Aw, this ice is so cold.

Vickie and Victor drag Veronica toward the shore.

The Witch uses her broom to stand back up. She wipes frost off of her face and waves her magic wand.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Hocus-pocus may the aquatic  
thermodynamics reverse focus!

Electricity shoots out of the wand, striking the ice with a boom. The ice cracks, splitting out in all directions.

VICKIE

The ice is breaking!

Vickie, Veronica and Victor rush for the shore.

Vickie trips face-first over an ice embedded log.

VICKIE (CONT'D)

Ouch!

Veronica and Victor yank her back up.

VERONICA

Are you okay?

Vickie sees a rift in the ice streaking toward them.

VICKIE

We've got to hurry!

Vickie, Veronica and Victor run, reaching the shore just as the lake breaks apart into a thousand bobbing chunks of ice.

Valerie and Vern rush up.

VALERIE  
Vickie your fang tooth?

VERN  
It's missing?

Vickie panics, realizing her top left fang tooth is gone.

VICKIE  
It must of fallen out when I fell down.

The Witch hovers above them on her broom with Vickie's tooth.

WITCH  
(sing-song)  
*Nanny nanny boo-boo,  
Stick your head in doo-doo!*

VICKIE  
Give me back my tooth!

The Witch blows a raspberry at her and flies away.

VERONICA  
Mommy and Daddy say to put your tooth  
under your pillow at bedtime after it  
falls out and you'll have a new one when  
you wake up.

VICTOR  
She's right. If you don't, you'll only  
have one fang tooth.

VERN  
I'm hungry.

VALERIE  
Me too.

VICTOR  
Okay, let's go home and make some  
marshmallow s'mores. Sorry The Witch  
stole your tooth Vickie.

Victor, Vern and Valerie walk off.

VICKIE  
I've got to go find that dingbat Witch's  
house and get my tooth back.

VERONICA  
What about the snowstorm?



A full moon shines in the sky.

VICKIE  
There's not a cloud in sight.

VERONICA  
What if you get lost?

VICKIE  
I'll leave a trail of bread crumbs.

VERONICA  
You'll need more bread. And take my hot  
cocoa mix in case you get thirsty.

Veronica gives Vickie her bread and a packet of cocoa mix.

VICKIE  
Thanks. And remember to go straight home.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie walks along a spooky trail in a snowstorm.

VICKIE  
(singing)  
*A-tisket, a-tasket  
The nitwit Witch stole my tooth,  
A-tisket, a-tasket  
I'm gonna stuff her into a smelly old  
wastebasket.*

She passes by a giant tree, dropping bread crumbs.

WALLY WOLF, a big WOLF who walks awkwardly upright, creeps  
out from behind the tree gobbling up the bread.

WALLY  
Yummy!

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie drops crumbs at the same giant tree she recently  
walked past.

VICKIE  
Hmm, this tree looks awfully familiar?

She flips off her hood.

VICKIE (CONT'D)  
Ahh fiddlesticks! I've been going in  
circles. But where'd all my bread crumbs  
go?

She spots a pair of huge paw prints leading behind the tree and sneaks behind it.

Wally peeks out from the other side of the tree. The coast is clear and he struts out gobbling up the new bread crumbs.

WALLY

I love tasty bread crumbs.

Vickie tiptoes up behind him.

VICKIE

Boo!

WALLY

Ahh! Little girl you shouldn't be scaring people like that.

VICKIE

And you shouldn't be stealing my bread!

WALLY

Hey, I'm Wally the Big Bad Wolf and these here are my woods!

VICKIE

I don't care who you are. I am very busy tonight. So stop wasting my time and get lost.

WALLY

Sure, no problem at all. Just give me the rest of your scrumptious bread and I'll be on my way.

VICKIE

Okay.

She dangles bread in his face and tosses it into the bushes.

VICKIE (CONT'D)

Oops, it must of slipped out of my hand.

WALLY

That's okay, I'll find it!

Wally dives after it.

Vickie walks off down the trail.

Wally hops back out eating the bread.

He looks around, huffing and puffing.

WALLY (CONT'D)  
Why, that sneaky little girl tricked me.

He dramatically sprints after her and abruptly trips over his big clumsy feet.

WALLY (CONT'D)  
Ouch!

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie arrives at a fork in the trail.

The left path leads down a deep rocky ditch. The right path continues down the trail.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Wally swaggers up the trail.

WALLY  
(singing)  
*Fe Fi Fo Fum!*  
*I am the big bad wolf,*  
*And here I come.*

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie hears Wally approaching.

WALLY (O.S.)  
(singing)  
*Fe Fi Fo Fum! I'm the big bad wolf and I*  
*love yummy bread crumbs.*

VICKIE  
Good grief, it's that goofball wolf again.

Vickie tosses crumbs down the left path into the ditch.

She then walks backwards down the right side of the trail using her coat to wipe away her footprints behind her.

Wally prances up but sees no more footprints in the snow.

WALLY  
Where did she go?

He spots the bread crumbs, taking the bait.

WALLY (CONT'D)  
Ha! I know these woods like the back of my paws. I'll catch up to her in a jiffy.

He scoops up the bread crumbs down the left trail.

Wally doesn't notice the ditch and trips over it tumbling downwards against the rocks.

WALLY (CONT'D)

Ouch!

EXT. SKY - NIGHT

The Witch flies her broomstick through the snowstorm.

WITCH

(singing)

*Vickie had a little tooth,  
Little tooth, little tooth.  
And everywhere that Vickie went,  
Her mean girl tooth will never ever go.*

She swoops down toward the treetops.

EXT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

The Witch lands down at her charming little house made out of gingerbread, icing and colorful candies.

She checks her red mailbox and it's empty.

WITCH

I never get any mail. I bet Veronica  
would be my friend and send me letters if  
her big sister Vickie wasn't so mean.

INT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

The Witch enters her cozy house wiping off her boots.

WITCH

Well, one thing is for sure; Vickie will  
be sorry now that I have her tooth.

She puts the tooth on her coffee table.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Okay, time to make some herbal tea.

The Witch boils tea in a black cauldron.

EXT. VICKIE'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Veronica stuffs bread crumbs into a red bird feeder.

MR. CROW flies down and eats from it.

MR. CROW

Veronica why do you look so sad?

VERONICA

The Witch stole Vickie's tooth and she went looking for it. She's all alone out in the woods and I'm worried about her.

MR. CROW

Don't worry, I will help your sister.

VERONICA

Mr. Crow, thank you so much!

Mr. Crow soars off into the snowy sky.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie comes upon a big shaking bush in the snow.

WALLY (O.S.)

Little girl, I am the big bad bush!

Vickie realizes it's Wally behind the bush shaking it around.

VICKIE

I've never heard of a talking bush before. What do you want?

WALLY (O.S.)

For you to come a little closer so I can see you better.

VICKIE

And what a goofy voice you have for a bush?

WALLY (O.S.)

The better to talk to you with.

VICKIE

And what big paws you have. Do tell, why would a bush have big silly wolf paws?

Wally leaps out.

WALLY

The better to eat your yummy bread with!

Vickie kicks him in the shin.

WALLY (CONT'D)

Ouch!

Wally hops on one foot, clutching his shin.

VICKIE  
I'm not giving you my bread!

She stomps on his other foot and he face-plants groaning.

Vickie marches off.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Vickie stops at a stream with a broken rope bridge flapping in the wind.

VICKIE  
Great, what else could possibly go wrong tonight?

Wally limps up, huffing and puffing.

WALLY  
I've got you now.

VICKIE  
Not you again.

Mr. Crow and his flock of cawing CROWS scoop Vickie up, flying her over the stream.

WALLY  
You can't get away from me!

Wally tries leaping after her but trips over his clumsy feet into the stream.

WALLY (CONT'D)  
Aw! This water is so cold!

The stream's current carries him off downstream.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

The crows gently land Vickie across the stream.

VICKIE  
Thank you. You crows are so nice.

MR. CROW  
I promised Veronica I would help you.

VICKIE  
You know my sister?

MR. CROW

Yes, Veronica is so kind. She always remembers feed us birds. It was nice meeting you Vickie. But you better hurry along before that troublesome wolf shows back up.

VICKIE

Okay, and thanks again!

The crows soar off into the snowy sky.

Vickie trudges onward with frosty breath.

Vickie comes upon MR. SKUNK with his tail trapped under a small fallen tree.

He shivers as snow piles up around him, sticking to his fur.

MR. SKUNK

My lady, will you kindly help me? I fear  
I won't last much longer stuck like this.

A hefty jagged icicle dangles above him on a branch.

A howling wind blows the branch and the icicle creaks.

Vickie sees her blurry reflection in the icicle and steels herself.

VICKIE

Don't worry, I will help you.

She tries lifting the tree with all of her might but barely budes it.

Wally hobbles up soaking wet and shivering.

WALLY

What are you doing? He's a skunk!

Vickie struggles with the tree.

VICKIE

I don't care. Take my bread if you want it.

WALLY

You can't lift that. It's too heavy.

VICKIE

Well, don't just stand there. Help me.  
Unless you're not strong enough?

WALLY

Why, I'm the strongest wolf in all the land. Everyone knows that. Watch this!

Wally effortlessly lifts the tree, freeing Mr. Skunk.

WALLY (CONT'D)

See, what'd I tell you?

The icicle breaks free and drops straight down right where Mr. Skunk was just stuck.

MR. SKUNK

Much obliged to you both. I am forever indebted to your kindness.

VICKIE

You are most welcome Mr. Skunk.

Mr. Skunk shakes off the snow and waddles off.

Wally sobs.

VICKIE (CONT'D)

Why are you crying?

WALLY

Because you're so kind you'll even help a skunk. I used to be a good four-legged wolf and lived up on the mountain with my family.

VICKIE

So what happened?

WALLY

One day last summer I was playing in the woods with my little brother Willy.

BEGIN FLASHBACK: EXT. FOREST - DAY

Wally gracefully strides on all four legs through the sunny lush green forest.

WILLY WOLF, his little brother, chases after him.

WALLY

(sing-song)

*Roses are red,  
Violets are blue,*

Wally zigzags between two towering trees.



WALLY (CONT'D)  
(sing-song)  
*Turtles are slowpokes,  
And so are you!*

Wally leaps across a stream doing a flying front flip and lands perfectly on all fours.

Willy leaps after him, falling just short of clearing the stream and belly flops into the water.

WILLY  
Ouch!

Wally lifts him up out of the water flexing his biceps.

WALLY  
Don't worry baby brother someday you'll  
be big and strong just like me.

Willy shakes off the water.

Wally gets a whiff of a sweet scent and sniffs after it.

EXT. WITCH'S HOUSE - DAY

Wally and Willy emerge from the bushes at The Witch's Gingerbread House. Colorful candies and icing decorate it.

WALLY (V.O.)  
And that's when we found The Witch's  
house.

Wally licks his chops.

The Witch steps out in a "Kiss The Cook" apron carrying a freshly baked brick of steaming gingerbread.

WILLY  
Momma always says to stay away from The  
Witch.

Wally shushes him.

The Witch replaces a slightly weathered gingerbread brick with her fresh new one.

WITCH  
Hocus-pocus!

She waves her wand and fresh icing magically seals the brick in place.

She then goes back inside.

WALLY

Let's race back home. I'll even give you  
a ten second head start. Ten, nine,  
eight...

WILLY

Okay!

Willy sprints off into the woods.

WALLY

Sticks and stones may break my bones, but  
one little tasty bite of yummy  
gingerbread won't hurt me.

Wally creeps up to the house, yanking off the fresh  
gingerbread.

INT. WITCH'S HOUSE - DAY

The Witch traces her fingers over her crystal ball.

WITCH

Recall, recall, snarky crystal ball. Who  
has the finest gingerbread house of them  
all?

Fog fills the crystal ball and then vanishes, revealing an  
oversized ostentatious gingerbread house.

CRYSTAL BALL

Your snooty big sister Wilhelmina The  
Witch has the finest gingerbread house in  
all the land. Everyone knows that. Duh!

WITCH

What? That pompous monstrosity!

CRYSTAL BALL

At least her house is all in one piece.

The crystal ball shows the spot of her missing gingerbread.

WITCH

No, it can't be!

EXT. WITCH'S HOUSE - DAY

The Witch storms out spotting Wally's paw prints.

She follows them and catches him devouring her gingerbread.

WITCH

How dare you eat my house!

Her shadow spreads over him as she brandishes her wand.

WALLY (V.O.)

And that's when she put this spell on me.

WITCH

Abra double trouble cadabra!

Wally cowers as light shoots out of the wand, blasting him.

END FLASHBACK.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Wally sobs in the snow.

WALLY

And I've been stuck down here in this forest ever since because I'm too clumsy now to get back home on only two feet. And I have no friends.

VICKIE

I'll be your friend if you stop your crying. And take me to The Witch's house.

Wally wipes away his tears.

WALLY

Okay, I know a short cut. Follow me!

EXT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Vickie and Wally peek in the window and see The Witch sleeping in her rocking chair.

Wally sneezes.

WALLY

Ahh-choo!

VICKIE

I'm going to sneak in and get my tooth back.

WALLY

I'll come with you.

VICKIE

No. You'll wake her up with all your sneezing.

WALLY

I won't sneeze. I promise.

VICKIE

Fine, just be quiet so we don't get caught.

Vickie softly turns the doorknob.

INT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Vickie and Wally creep in as The Witch snores.

DREAM SEQUENCE - EXT. POND - DAY

MR. BULLFROG sunbathes by a pond wearing sunglasses.

The Witch walks up with a bouquet of roses.

WITCH

Mr. Bullfrog, if you kiss me I'll turn you into a handsome prince and together we can live happily every after.

He scoffs and swiftly hops away from her. The Witch sighs, rejected.

END DREAM SEQUENCE

INT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Wally is about to sneeze. Vickie shushes him.

Vickie tiptoes toward her tooth on the coffee table.

Wally sniffs the sweet aroma of the gingerbread wall.

He licks his chops drooling and loses control and sneezes.

WALLY

Ahh-choo!

The Witch jolts awake, knocking over her boiling cauldron.

Tea spills out, burning Wally's feet and he slips and falls.

WALLY (CONT'D)

Ouch! My paws are burning!

WITCH

Well if it isn't little Vickie. You thought you could just sneak in here and get your tooth back did you? And you Wally Wolf, what did I say about eating my house!

VICKIE

It's my tooth and I'm taking it back.

WITCH

That's what you think. I'm going to turn  
you both into itty-bitty little worms.

Wally cowers behind Vickie.

WALLY

No, not worms!

The Witch raises her wand about to cast a spell when Mr.  
Skunk suddenly kicks open the door.

MR. SKUNK

Put down that wand!

The Witch gets startled and stumbles, dropping her wand.

WITCH

Ahh! A skunk!

Mr. Skunk snatches the wand, aiming it at her.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Hey, be careful with that! It's not a  
toy.

MR. SKUNK

I should turn you into a tree stump for  
stealing from this nice little girl.

WALLY

I like that idea.

The Witch begins to sob, disappointed with herself.

WITCH

Oh you're right, stealing is wrong. But,  
she started it. People are always picking  
on me and now my tea is all ruined.

VICKIE

Do you like hot cocoa?

WITCH

I love hot cocoa!

Vickie gives her Veronica's cocoa mix.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Sorry for stealing your tooth.

She gives Vickie back her tooth.

VICKIE

It's okay. And I'm sorry for being mean.

The Witch heats up the cocoa in her cauldron.

WITCH

I wish I had friends like you guys.

VICKIE

We'll be your friends.

WITCH

Really! I know a friendship spell!

She flips opens her spell book.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Wave the wand at me and say these words.

Mr. Skunk gives Vickie the wand.

VICKIE

(waving the wand)

Alakazam, friendship is the best magic of all!

Nothing magical actually happens, but The Witch doesn't even notice because she's just so happy to finally have friends.

WITCH

Wow! I've never had any friends before!

VICKIE

Time to reverse Wally's spell so he can go back home to his family up on the mountain.

Vickie gives The Witch her wand and she waves it.

WITCH

Prest-O Change-O!

A flash of light shoots out transforming Wally back into his normal four-legged self.

WALLY

Wow! This is so great. I'm me again!

WITCH

Can I do anything for you Mr. Skunk?

MR. SKUNK

Yes, you can be more quiet.

WITCH

I'll be quiet, I promise.

MR. SKUNK

Thank you. Now I can finally read my new book in peace and quiet. It's a fairy tale about a girl named Red Riding Hood.

Mr. Skunk waddles out the door.

VICKIE

Goodbye Mr. Skunk!

The Witch pours mugs of cocoa for them, toasting Vickie.

WITCH

WALLY

(singing)

(singing)

*For she's a jolly good vampire,  
For Vickie's a jolly good vampire,  
Which nobody can deny!*

A cuckoo clock strikes the hour and a black CUCKOO CAT springs out.

CUCKOO CAT

Cuckoo! Cuckoo!

VICKIE

Oh no it's almost dawn. I'll never make it home in time to put my tooth under my pillow before sunrise.

WALLY

Yes you will! Hop on my back, I'll get you home in a jiffy.

WITCH

No, I'll fly you home on my super duper fast broom.

EXT. WITCH'S HOUSE - NIGHT

The snowstorm has stopped.

The Witch gives Wally chestnuts.

WITCH

Here's some roasted chestnuts to share with your family.

WALLY

Thank you. And thank you Vickie!

Wally gracefully darts off on all fours.

VICKIE

Goodbye Wally!

WITCH

Vickie hop on and hold on tight.

Vickie hops on the back of the broom.

WITCH (CONT'D)

Giddy up broom!

The broomstick springs to life, skyrocketing them upwards.

EXT. NIGHTY NIGHT - NIGHT

The Witch flies Vickie over the village, doing a roll over.

EXT. VICKIE'S HOUSE - NIGHT

The Witch lands Vickie down in her backyard.

Veronica peeks out the window.

VERONICA

Hurry up. Mommy and Daddy just got home.

WITCH

Hi Veronica. I'm a good witch now.

VERONICA

I never thought you were bad before.

WITCH

You were the first person to ever be nice to me and I promise to repay you. But for now we need to get Vickie inside.

The Witch lifts Vickie up and Veronica pulls her inside.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

Vickie and Veronica peek out their window.

VICKIE

Thank you so much.

WITCH

Happy to help.



The girls hear their parents approaching the door.

VICKIE

It's our parents. We have to go to bed.

WITCH

I'll stop by and say hi the next time I fly through town.

WITCH

Uh-oh, Vickie's other tooth fell out.

She floats up on her broom, peeking in the window.

WITCH (CONT'D)

They're both sleeping. I'll just have to put it under her pillow myself.

INT. BEDROOM - DAWN

The Witch slips the tooth under Vickie's pillow.

Two shiny silver coins fall out of her pocket, clinking on the floor.

She picks them up and tucks them under Vickie's pillow.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

And this children, was how The Witch  
found her true calling and became the  
world famous Tooth Fairy. But, that's a  
another story for another day.

EXT. NIGHTY NIGHT - DAY

The Witch flies over the village with colorful smoke spraying  
from the back of her broom.

EXT. FROZEN LAKE - NIGHT

Vickie teaches Veronica how to ice-skate. They wear matching  
red coats and Veronica now has on a pair of beautiful white  
skates.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

The next evening Vickie woke up with two  
brand new fang teeth. And with the Tooth  
Fairy's silver coins, Vickie bought  
Veronica a brand new pair of ice skates.

Wally and Willy howl a friendly "hello" at them from up on a  
hilltop.

Vickie and Veronica wave for them come join them and they  
joyfully trot down toward them.
